| Additional Information | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The problem was discovered when FSIS collected a routine product sample that confirmed positive for the presence of <i>E. coli</i> O157:H7.• <i>E. coli</i> O157:H7 is a potentially deadly bacterium that can cause dehydration, bloody diarrhea and abdominal cramps 2–8 days (3–4 days, on average) after exposure to the organism. While most people recover within a week, some develop a type of kidney failure called hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS). This condition can occur among persons of any age but is most common in children under 5-years old and older adults. It is marked by easy bruising, pallor, and decreased urine output.• There have been no confirmed reports of adverse reactions due to consumption of these products. |
